
Overview

This package consists of 3 nights in the historic town of Victoria Falls named after the falls which were first seen by Dr David Livingstone in 1855 and named it so after the queen of England and 3 nights in a private lodge in Hwange National Park.

Victoria Falls or Mosi-oa-Tunya (the smoke that thunders) in the local Kololo language is aptly described as one of the seven natural wonders of the world and a must see for any visitor to southern Africa. Located on the mighty Zambezi River the falls are 1.7km wide and 108 metres high and has an annual average flow of one million litres per second.

The package includes a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, guide tour of Chinotimba Township and 3 hour game drive. There is also an abundance of other activities you can book including walk with the lions, elephant back safaris, white water rafting, river cruises, helicopter rides, bungee jumping, jet boating, hiking, canoeing and fishing. Hwange National Park is 14,650 sq km in size and is the largest Park in Zimbabwe and is named after a local Nhanzwa chief. It is located in the northwest corner of Zimbabwe and is about an hour south of the Victoria Falls. Hwange boasts a huge selection of wildlife with over 100 species of mammals and 400 species of birds. The elephants of Hwange are world famous and the elephant population is one of the largest in the world. Your package includes daily game drives in the park.

Itinerary

Day 1

On arrival at Victoria Falls airport you will be met by your Wild Africa Travel Company representative and transferred to your Victoria Falls hotel for your 3 night stay. Both hotels are only a short walk to the falls and you have the chance to spend time witnessing its power.

Day 2

This morning you will picked up from your hotel for an early morning 3 hour game drives conducted in open safari vehicles with a qualified game guide. You may enjoy a variety of sightings from animals and birds to insects and trees before returning to their hotel.

In the late afternoon you will be taken on a sunset cruise of the Zambezi River which is a superb way to relax and enjoy the beauty of the River. Clients may have the opportunity to see a variety of game; including hippo, crocodile, elephant as well as enjoy the many different bird species. The Sunset cruise is very popular and includes finger snacks, beer, wine, local spirits and soft drinks. There are great photo opportunities against often-spectacular African sunsets.

Day 3

This morning you will embark on the Chinotimba Township tour. The word Chinotimba describes the roar of the water from the mighty Victoria Falls in the local Nambya language. The Nambya and the Tonga people are the original people of the Victoria Falls area. The majority of people in Victoria Falls live in the Chinotimba township, which has a population of approximately 60,000 people.

During this tour, you will have an opportunity to observe township life from the oldest houses to the taverns, the local market and churches. You will also visit to the Chinotimba Primary School where you are introduced to the school headmaster where they or someone assigned will take the guests on a tour of the school after which the children may sing a song (Please note that school visits are subject to the schools being open)

Day 4

Your final opportunity to see the falls before checking out of your hotel and being transferred to your Hwange National Park accommodation for your 3 night stay.

Day 5 - 6

Your days can be as adventurous or as relaxing as you wish as you have the option of early morning and late afternoon game drives with experienced guides through the park. You can also relax and wile away your time in the comforts of your accommodation.

Day 7

After an early morning game drive check out of your accommodation and you will be transferred to Victoria Falls airport and your flight to your next destination.



Accommodations

Superior Accommodation The Kingdom at Victoria Falls

The Kingdom at Victoria Falls is an excellent destination for both individual travellers and families. The hotel was built on the edges of a man made lake, and it boasts 292 rooms and 4 suites. Outward facing rooms have views of the Victoria Falls National Park and World Heritage Site where wildlife can be seen roaming freely. The remainder of the rooms have views of the man-made lake and waterfalls. The Kingdom has its own food court offering a wide selection of meals, as well as offering its guests 3 swimming pools and a toddlers pool, a children's play area and casino. The architecture of the Kingdom was inspired by the ancient kingdom of Munhumutapa, with great domes, pillars, and bridges over the many water features. The Victoria Falls are just 10 minutes walk away from the resort.



Hwange Safari Lodge

Hwange Safari Lodge is situated just outside the borders of the wellknown Hwange National Park, and essentially forms part of the Park. Hwange Safari Lodge in Zimbabwe is only an hour's drive from the Victoria Falls on the road from Bulawayo. At Hwange Safari Lodge guests are accommodated in tastefully decorated rooms with airconditioning, fan and heating. All rooms overlook either the waterhole, savanna bush or swimming pool. Guests shouldn't be too surprised if they can spot a curious elephant from their window. All rooms have mosquito nets, tea/coffee-making facilities, coffee table and lounge chairs, hairdryer, telephone and a writing desk. The Lodge has two restaurants: the Dingani Restaurant and the open air pool area. The Dingani Restaurant offers an a la carte menu and has a splendid view of the surrounding bush through the glass windows and sliding doors. The pool area offers snacks and light meals, buffet breakfasts, lunch and dinners, and a bonfire is made every night. The highlights at Hwange Safari Lodge are the guided night or daytime game drives. If you don't feel like venturing into the bush, you can simply enjoy the parade of animals visiting the waterhole.



Deluxe Accommodation Victoria Falls Hotel

The Victoria Falls Hotel, which is popularly known as 'the grand old lady of the Falls, is situated within the Victoria Falls National Park, a World Heritage Site. The Edwardian-style five-star hotel, was built in 1904 and has been recently redecorated and fully refurbished to combine the old charm with the convenience of the new. The hotel is set in tropical gardens with palm trees, semi-tropical shrubs and lily ponds and it provides a tranquil and secluded setting that many guests seek. The famous Victoria Falls are just a ten-minute walk away using the hotels private pathway, and the smoke that thunders or 'Mosi-O-Tunya' in the local dialect, is clearly audible and visible from the hotel. First class service, with food and beverage choices and preparation that are second to none. The opulent Livingstone Room for fine dining and dancing, the Jungle Junction with its famous breakfast and dinner buffets and ethnic entertainment in the evenings, offer variety and wide choice. Stanley's Terrace, with its clear view of the Victoria Falls Bridge which connects Zimbabwe with Zambia, is renowned for its cocktails and afternoon teas. The Terrace has been a meeting point for adventurers in Africa for over a century.



The Hide Safari Camp
